
## Mathis Wackernagel

Sustainability Strategist: Enabling One-Planet Prosperity



If you've heard of the carbon or ecological **footprint**, we've already met. Over 30 years ago in Vancouver, Canada, I conceived and developed the footprint metric with my PhD advisor. Today, it has become a global shorthand for measuring human impact on the planet—and for exposing <u>overshoot</u>: humanity's overuse of Earth's resources. To help address overshoot, I co-founded <u>Global Footprint</u>

Network over 20 years ago, a sustainability think tank known for its annual calculations comparing the ecological footprint and biocapacity of every country. These calculations reveal a stark reality: humanity currently uses the equivalent of <u>1.7 Earths</u>.

My passion lies not just in understanding global <u>overshoot</u> but in empowering cities, companies, and countries to navigate this challenging reality. What's missing, I believe, is <u>internal motivation</u>. Too often, we're told that change is futile or merely a noble cause. I argue the opposite: preparing for our new planetary context is in everyone's direct self-interest. The less others act, the more essential it becomes for each city, company, or country to prepare themselves. It's as practical as brushing your teeth—or, to put it bluntly, avoiding self-harm.

Based on the <u>recognitions</u> I've received, you might think all problems are solved. Unfortunately, that's far from true. Still, I feel blessed by the accolades which include the 2024 "<u>Nobel Sustainability Award</u>", the 2024 "<u>Orden de la Democracia Simón Bolivar</u>" from the Colombian parliament, the 2018 <u>World Sustainability Award</u>, the 2015 <u>IAIA Global Environment Award</u>, the 2012 <u>Blue Planet Prize</u>, and several honorary doctorates. One of the greatest rewards, however, is the opportunity to engage with diverse audiences and spark meaningful conversations.
